Capacity Building Workshop By:PIET Panipat November-2025






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Workshop For TGTs @DIET YNR November-2025

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

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



Double-coding is when two trained observers independently code the same classroom lesson at the same time; codes are later compared, discussed, and reconciled to maintain inter-rater reliability and reduce observer bias. This is a standard practice for robust classroom observation systems.

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
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


Online Orientation STEAM @SCERT HR


